**OCEAN Accelerator** 

The OCEAN Accelerator is a 17-week program designed to help founders build venturebackable companies. The program provides seed funding, mentorship, education, and professional services to support the growth of participating startups. Along with traditional accelerator elements, the OCEAN Accelerator invites founders to integrate their faith, purpose, relationships, and health into their startup journey.

About 90% of high-tech startups fail within 18 months. OCEAN Accelerator Alumni are beating the odds in every way. 60% of OCEAN Accelerator Alumni are still in operation throughout all cohorts.

80% of companies in Cohort 8 were led by underrepresented founders, making 45% of the whole OCEAN Accelerator Alumni portfolio led underrepresented founders.

As of 2022, our alumni have raised more than \$125M in financing. They have been accepted into leading startup programs, earned global and local recognition, and created more than 200 jobs.

During Demo Day 2022, Faith & Co created a video called "FOUNDERS". It is part of the Faith & Co videos Season 5, "Faithful Investing." The mini-documentary debuted at the 2022 Faith Driven Entrepreneur global conference simulcast to more than 300 host sites around the world. The film will continue to be distributed through Faith & Co courses and mini-series', showcasing OCEAN's unique perspective in guiding entrepreneurs through the business challenges and personal toll of building a new venture.

Since their debut in 2018, Cloverleaf has helped scale coaching and maximize employee talent for over 20,000 teams including major organizations like HP Enterprise, Monster Energy, Kroger and many more. In 2022, Cloverleaf closed **\$9M in a Series A funding** led by Origin Ventures. They were also recognized as a "top workplace" and "startup to watch" by the Cincinnati Business Courier.

Arkestro has made astounding progress towards their mission to amplify the impact of procurement's influence and has experienced significant organic growth with top enterprises leveraging their technology. In Fall 2022 Arkestro raised \$26 million in Series A funding to keep growing their platform.



Scheduler AI (previously Get Together AI) Accelerator Cohort 7 Alumni



## Cenesis Entrepreneurship Training launch a new business without losing your soul.



Genesis is a nine-week training program that helps entrepreneurs from any industry or location apply foundational business acumen and timeless wisdom to take their dream from idea to action.

With 30+ sessions of self-guided lessons and weekly facilitated cohort workshops, Genesis helps entrepreneurs build a business plan that's ready to grow and helps integrate their values into their daily work.

Since the program launched in 2018, 342 entrepreneurs from 29 states and 9 countries have participated.

There are a lot of ways to start a new business, many of them to the detriment of everything else truly important in life. We believe there is a better way, a way rooted in the timeless teachings and example of Jesus, a way that helps entrepreneurs build from purpose, overflow, and rest, instead of selfishness, scarcity, and panic.

There are two ways entrepreneurs join Genesis. Many sign up online for an OCEAN-hosted cohort, where they join a group of entrepreneurs from anywhere in the world and a trained volunteer facilitator.

OCEAN also works with other organizations to offer Genesis to their community-members. We were pleased to work with the following partners in 2022, who gathered a cohort of entrepreneurs from their community to journey through Genesis together.




Entrepreneurship should be accessible to everyone -- not just those who can afford business school. Thanks to the generous OCEAN community, 19 people benefited from a lowincome entrepreneur scholarship, reducing the cost of Genesis by 80%.

### THE PEOPLE

Have you heard the phrase, "measure what matters?" We believe that founder health and company culture matter as much as annual revenue or successful fundraising. That's why we regularly check-in with entrepreneurs in our training programs to understand where they *started* with their business acumen, relational health, and spiritual integration, and how their views and practices *changed* through the course of their training program. Based on quick "pulse" checkins, facilitators, mentors, and staff are able to respond to the most pressing needs, as well as continue improving the training programs.

# hustle culture is a lie

In 2014, a group of entrepreneurs threw a party in Cincinnati and called it Unpolished.

They were done with the fake shine of "hustle-culture" and wanted to host an honest conversation about the gritty, lonely, and uncertain parts of entrepreneurship. Hundreds of people showed up for the first Unpolished night, and from there it grew into an annual conference attracting thousands of curious and faith-driven entrepreneurs. In 2018, Unpolished merged with OCEAN Accelerator to become OCEAN Programs.

In 2022, OCEAN revived the "unpolished" conversations, launching the Unpolished tour to reach hundreds of entrepreneurs in key cities who experience the same tension. The roadshow invites people in tech & entrepreneurship to consider how faith relates to their work and help them activate their dreams & skills for the kingdom.

Unpolished events in 2022 welcomed 200 attendees from 6 cities out west as well as Cincinnati. In 2023, we plan to visit 10 more cities through the Midwest and East coast. At an Unpolished night, we talk about the gritty, lonely, and uncertain parts of entrepreneurship and technology. Attendees are part of thought-provoking conversation where they consider how faith relates to their work + help you activate their dreams & skills for the kingdom. Speakers share parts of their real-life story, have an honest conversation together, and then engage together as a community.

The most important entrepreneurial behavior I hope you'll notice from OCEAN is that our motivation to build, create and serve entrepreneurs is **love**.

Just like business leaders, it's easy for us to get caught up in the day-to-day of operating and growing an organization. We have KPIs, big rocks, OKRs (whatever terminology you prefer!) ... deadlines, budgets, and meetings. It's frighteningly easy for us to lose touch with our 'why' - not out of malicious intent or arrogance, but in the regular grind and demand of good, hard work.

So, while I hope you notice an abundance of entrepreneurial behavior from OCEAN, I also invite you to hold us to the standard we set for ourselves: that the purpose of our entrepreneurial behavior is in service of entrepreneurs.
